About us

We are a non-profit private exhibition space in London E17.

Our mission is to run varied programme of exhibitions, showing new socially conscious, thoughtful and thought-provoking art, and supporting emerging artists.

Our exhibitions and our collaborators

We're open to ideas but the criteria below set out our preferences and reflect what we've seen work best in the space.

- Exhibitions which are cause-related or exploring a particular theme.
- Artists with a strong connection to East London.
- Group shows (minimum 3 artists) which are self-curated.
- We're open to artists with different perspectives with artworks which reflect their own values and opinions.
- We welcome people who have had few, or no, exhibitions before, and those with more experience perhaps working in a group with others who are less experienced.
- We want to make an asset from our small, private space; exhibitors should be willing and able to use the space creatively, bring it to life and respond to its location.
- We welcome all kinds of work not just hung work but sculpture, sound, film, and larger installations could all work well.

What we'll do

- Provide the space free of charge (no rental charge) although we do ask for a small donation towards our costs.
- Make the space available for an exhibition for 2-4 days over a weekend, including an evening for a private view.
- Agree 'terms and conditions' with you, specific to your event.
- Publicise the event using our own growing mailing list, social media and local networks.
- Be as helpful and accommodating as possible, bearing in mind we both work at other jobs – but we will be flexible and help as much as we can including welcoming friends and guests to a private view.

What we ask of you

 Artists are responsible for all aspects of their exhibition including: curation, marketing, running a booking system, setting up & taking down, being on site when it's open and leaving the space clean and tidy afterwards.

- Please bear in mind that this isn't intended to be a commercial space, and that footfall is limited because of the size and limited time-period of exhibitions. If you do sell works, that's great, but we ask you to manage all aspects of this.
- Remember that this is a private space in a residential area, which means we must ask
 attendees to book ahead; neighbours and local residents are supportive and many now
 attend our events but we need to ensure we end shows and private views on time to
 avoid disturbance.
